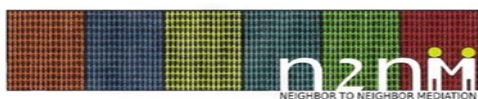

This 40-hour training is open to the public. Typical attendees include those wishing to volunteer as mediators for CDRCs, lawyers, business people, teachers, counselors, and anyone who wants to learn constructive ways to deal with conflict. The concepts and skills taught can be applied not only formally as a mediator, but individually while informally interacting with others at home, at work, or out in the community. This training is largely experiential including small group exercises, role plays, and class discussion. Training includes an extensive manual that will cover such topics as:

- Overview of Conflict Resolution systems
- Conflict dynamics, concepts, and style
- Formal mediation process model
- Interpersonal communication skills
- Role of the mediator
- Co-mediation
- Neutrality and bias
- Positions, interests, values, and basic needs
- Mediator ethics, protocol, and professional standards
- Cultural awareness
- Case Development (for volunteers)
