Neighbor-to-Neighbor is offering a six-hour training course on November 9th, 2026, from 8:00 am- 2:00 pm at the Neighbor-to-Neighbor Administrative Office, for mediators interested in mediating court-related cases. This training is compliant with the Oregon Judicial Dept. Court-Connected Mediation Qualification Rules, Chief Justice Order No 05-028) and satisfies the additional training requirements to mediate and Small Claims.

County Circuit courts across Oregon offer mediation services to plaintiffs and defendants prior to parties presenting their case before a judge. This training will cover how mediation fits into the broader court process, the implications of mediating in a court process, and the types of cases you will likely mediate the most in small claims or FED court. Neighbor to Neighbor's interactive approach means you will be participating in role play mediations, group discussions, and activities throughout the training.

An FED Module will follow on the same day beginning at 2:30 pm and covers the unique specifics to mediation in Landlord/Tenant cases, the forms, processes and roleplay. FED mediators must have the first module or prior small-claims training to attend this part of the training.

The training is free for those volunteering with Neighbor to Neighbor, and \$150 for all others. **A Basic Mediation Training of 32 hours or equivalent experience** is a prerequisite for this training. To register, visit us online at: n2nmediation.org or click here:
